1. Introduction

The Academy of Science Tutoring Ltd collects, processes, and stores personal data in order to operate effectively and deliver educational services. This includes information relating to parents/carers, students, tutors, staff, suppliers, and other individuals with whom the organisation has a professional relationship.

This policy explains how personal data must be collected, used, stored, and protected to ensure compliance with data protection legislation and to uphold the rights of individuals.

The Academy of Science Tutoring Ltd is **registered with the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO)** and is committed to handling personal data lawfully, fairly, and transparently.

2. Purpose of the Policy

This policy ensures that The Academy of Science Tutoring Ltd:

- Complies with data protection legislation and recognised good practice
 - Protects the rights and privacy of children, parents/carers, tutors, and staff
 - Is transparent about how personal data is collected and used
 - Minimises the risk of data breaches and reputational damage

3. Legal Framework

This policy is written in accordance with the following legislation and guidance:

- UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR)
- Data Protection Act 2018
- Privacy and Electronic Communications Regulations (PECR)
- Human Rights Act 1998
- Guidance from the Information Commissioner's Office (ICO)

These laws apply to all personal data, whether stored electronically, on paper, or in any other format.

4. Data Protection Principles

In line with UK GDPR, personal data must be:

1. Processed lawfully, fairly, and transparently
2. Collected for specified, explicit, and legitimate purposes
3. Adequate, relevant, and limited to what is necessary
4. Accurate and kept up to date
5. Kept for no longer than necessary
6. Processed in accordance with individuals' rights
7. Stored securely and protected against unauthorised or unlawful processing, loss, or damage
8. Not transferred outside the UK or European Economic Area unless adequate safeguards are in place

5. Scope of the Policy

This policy applies to:

- All directors of The Academy of Science Tutoring Ltd
- All employees, tutors, contractors, and volunteers

It applies to all personal data held by the organisation, including but not limited to:

- Names
- Postal addresses
- Email addresses
- Telephone numbers
- Educational and attendance records
- Any other information that can identify an individual

6. Responsibilities

6.1 Directors

The **directors** of The Academy of Science Tutoring Ltd are collectively responsible for ensuring compliance with data protection legislation and for overseeing the implementation of this policy.

6.2 Staff and Tutors

All individuals working on behalf of the organisation are responsible for:

- Handling personal data in line with this policy
- Completing any required data protection training
- Reporting data protection concerns or breaches promptly to the directors

7. Data Protection Risks

This policy helps reduce risks including:

- Accidental or deliberate breaches of confidentiality

- Inappropriate sharing or misuse of personal data
- Loss, theft, or unauthorised access to data
- Reputational and legal consequences following a data breach

8. General Data Handling Guidelines

- Access to personal data is limited to individuals who require it to perform their role
- Personal data must not be shared informally or without proper authorisation
- Strong passwords must be used and never shared
- Personal data must not be disclosed to unauthorised individuals, internally or externally
- Data must be reviewed regularly and deleted securely when no longer required
- Any uncertainty regarding data protection must be referred to the directors

9. Data Storage and Security

9.1 Paper Records

- Stored in locked cabinets or secure locations
- Not left unattended or visible to unauthorised individuals
- Shredded securely when no longer required

9.2 Electronic Records

- Protected by strong, regularly updated passwords
- Stored only on approved devices, systems, and cloud services
- Regularly backed up and tested
- Protected by up-to-date security software and firewalls
- Removable media must be encrypted or securely locked away

10. Use of Personal Data

When accessing or using personal data:

- Screens must be locked when devices are unattended
- Data must only be used for legitimate business purposes
- Personal data must not be transferred outside the UK or EEA without appropriate safeguards

11. Data Accuracy

The Academy of Science Tutoring Ltd will take reasonable steps to ensure personal data is accurate and up to date.

- Data will be stored in as few systems as possible
- Individuals will be encouraged to update their details
- Inaccurate or outdated data will be corrected or deleted promptly

12. Individual Rights and Subject Access Requests

Individuals have the right to:

- Know what personal data is held about them and why
- Access their personal data
- Request correction or deletion of their data
- Restrict or object to processing
- Request data portability where applicable

Subject Access Requests (SARs)

Requests should be made by email to:

admin@theacademyofsciencetutoring.com

- A standard form can be provided but is not required
- Identity will be verified before any data is released
- Requests will be responded to within **one month**, in line with UK GDPR
- No fee will usually be charged unless the request is excessive or repetitive

13. Disclosure of Data

Personal data may be disclosed without consent where legally required, including requests from law enforcement or safeguarding authorities.

Any such disclosure will be assessed by the directors to ensure it is lawful and proportionate.

14. Transparency and Fair Processing

The Academy of Science Tutoring Ltd ensures individuals are informed about:

- What data is collected
- How it is used
- Their rights under data protection law

This information is provided through privacy notices and contractual documentation.

15. GDPR Compliance and Data Breaches

The Academy of Science Tutoring Ltd complies fully with UK GDPR requirements.

- Personal data is only shared internally on a need-to-know basis, including with tutors where necessary to deliver services
- The organisation does not send unsolicited marketing communications
- Data breaches will be reported to the ICO without undue delay and, where required, within **72 hours**

Individuals affected by a data breach will be informed where there is a high risk to their rights or freedoms.

16. Right to Erasure

Individuals have the right to request deletion of their personal data where it is no longer required or where there is no lawful basis for processing.

Requests should be made to admin@theacademyofsciencetutoring.com and will be handled in line with legal requirements.

17. Policy Review

This policy will be reviewed annually or sooner if there are changes in legislation, guidance, or organisational practice.
